Salads in a Jar



Caprese Pasta Salad

- 2 tbsp basil pesto
(homemade or store-bought)
- 1 cup cherry tomatoes
- 1 ½ oz fresh mozzarella,
chopped into bite sized pieces
- 2 oz cooked penne pasta
- ½ cup fresh spinach leaves
- ½ cup fresh basil, chopped

Chickpea Salad

- 2 tbsp easy lemon vinaigrette (see right)
- 1 cup chickpeas
- ½ cup sun-dried or oven roasted tomatoes
- ¼ cup spring onion, chopped
- ¼ cup red onion, chopped
- ½ cup olives, chopped
- ¼ cup piquillo peppers, chopped
- ½ cup fresh spinach

Greek Pasta Salad

- 2 tbsp easy lemon vinaigrette (see below)
- 1 cup cherry tomatoes
- ¼ cup red onion, chopped
- 1 cup cucumber, chopped
- ½ cup feta, crumbled
- 2 oz rigatoni, cooked
- ½ cup mixed greens
- ½ cup fresh mint, chopped

Easy Lemon Vinaigrette

- (will make enough for 3-4 mason jars)
- Juice from one large lemon
- ½ cup olive oil
- Good pinch of salt
- Couple of grinds of black pepper

When you are ready to eat, shake the jar like crazy!






