COOKING WITH THE CONNECT CLUB

Last month our seminar was held at The Grill Works in Marion. We learned how to impress our friends and family with several unique and easy grilling methods! I thought I would share one of the many decilious recipes we learned to grill.

Plank Grilled Chipotle Salmon

Ingredients

- 4 to 6 boneless, skinless salmon fillets
- ¾ cup pineapple juice (6 oz. can)
- 1 grilling plank (alder or cedar recommended)

Chipotle Rub


- 3 T packed brown sugar
- 1½ T Sure Shot Sid's Chipotle Rub
- 1 tsp grated lime zest
- 3/4 tsp Galena Garlic Company Hickory Smoked Sea Salt

Instructions

- 1. Place salmon fillets into a one gallon zip lock plastic bag.
- 2. Pour pineapple juice over salmon.
- 3. Seal bag and refrigerate for 2 hours to marinate.
- 4. Soak plank in water for 2 hours.
- 5. Combine rub ingredients, set aside.
- 6. Preheat grill on medium high (350-400° F) for about 10 minutes.
- 7. Place plank on grill, preheat for 5 minutes.
- 8. Turn plank over.
- 9. Dredge top of salmon filets in rub (or sprinkle on top) and place on pre-heated plank. Close lid.
- 10. Cook for 12 to 15 minutes or until internal temperature reaches 135°.
- 11. Remove plank from gill with tongs and serve.





We will begin our tour viewing the beauty of the 1000 Islands Region of New York. On arrival in Alexandria Bay, we will take a Two Nations Sightseeing Cruise on the St. Lawrence River. This international tour offers historic and scenic wonders in both the Canadian and American sections of the 1000 Islands. Our tour begins at the U.S. Capitol Visitor Center with a guided tour of this historic and storied building. Then, we will discover the celebrated history of America's capital on a tour with a local expert. Delight in wonderful views of the White House, National Mall and many monuments and museums. We continue with stops at the moving World War II Memorial, the Vietnam Veterans Memorial and the Korean War Memorial.
