COOKING WITH THE CONNECT CLUB

Reuben Casserole



Ingredients

- 6 slices rye bread, divided
- 1 pound pastrami or corned beef, thinly sliced or shaved
- 1 (14.5 oz.) can sauerkraut
- 4 cups Swiss Cheese, shredded
- 1 cup dill pickles, chopped
- 1 cup milk
- 1/3 cup Thousand Island dressing
- 1/4 cup mustard
- 3 large eggs
- 2 teaspoons caraway seeds

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°F and lightly grease a 9×11-inch baking dish with butter or non-stick spray.
- 2. Take four pieces of rye bread and cut them into cubes. Place remaining bread in food processor, pulse until you've got fine breadcrumbs and set aside.
- 3. Spread cubed bread out along the bottom of your baking dish, then cover with 1/2 of pastrami. Top beef with sauerkraut, pickles, half of caraway seeds and 2 cups cheese.
- 4. Cover with remaining beef, caraway seeds and cheese.
- 5. In a medium bowl, whisk together milk, salad dressing and mustard, then beat in eggs until combined.
- 6. Pour wet ingredients evenly over the casserole, then top with breadcrumbs.
- 7. Place baking dish in oven and bake for 40-45 minutes, or until mixture is bubbly, top is browned and center is set.
- 8. Remove from oven and serve hot.

Castles, Flowers Falls

We will begin our tour viewing the beauty of the 1000 Islands Region of New York. On arrival in Alexandria Bay, we will take a Two Nations Sightseeing Cruise on the St. Lawrence River. This international tour offers historic and scenic wonders in both the Canadian and American sections of the 1000 Islands. We will disembark at Heart Island where we will take a tour of Boldt Castle, built at the turn-of-the-century by the millionaire proprietor of the world-famous Waldorf Astoria. In the afternoon, we will visit the New York Kitchen where their mission is to educate, engage and excite visitors by showcasing New York's finest in wine, food and agriculture in a setting that proudly highlights the natural beauty, rich history and agricultural bounty of New York State. We will learn about the Kitchen and then be treated to a gourmet dinner prepared especially for our group.

Our first stop on the third day will be at the George Eastman House for a guided tour of the restored Colonial Revival-style mansion, once home to the founder of the Eastman Kodak Company. After the tour, you will be able to walk through the formal gardens of the estate. Next, we're off to experience Rochester's Lilac Festival. Every May, the Festival signals the start of spring as 22 acres of Highland Park display more than 500 varieties of lilac bushes, from the deepest purple to the purest white, from lightly scented to irresistibly aromatic. Our group will be treated to lunch at the Elmwood Inn, a local favorite, before continuing on to Niagara Falls, Ontario. We will check into the beautiful Hilton Niagara Falls Hotel where everyone will have a view of Niagara Falls from their room!

We'll start our fourth day at the Floral Showhouse with its collection of orchids, succulents and other tropical plants. We'll make photo stops at Horseshoe Falls, the Floral Clock and the lilac gardens before our arrival in the charming, historic town of Niagara-on-the-Lake. This lovely village has been described as the prettiest town in Canada. Blocks and blocks of boutiques and cafés line the flower-filled streets. Next, we'll take an exciting boat ride on the Hornblower Niagara that will take us up close to the American and HorseShoe Falls. Our elegant farewell dinner will be in a revolving restaurant high atop the Skylon Tower.





Our tour begins at the U.S. Capitol Visitor Center with a guided tour of this historic and storied building. Then, we will discover the celebrated history of America's capital on a tour with a local expert. Delight in wonderful views of the White House, National Mall and many monuments and museums. We continue with stops at the moving World War II Memorial, the Vietnam Veterans Memorial and the Korean War Memorial. We will visit the White House Visitor Center, explore the history of 1600 Pennsylvania Avenue, and see artifacts from the White House collection. Your Choice: You can step into the pages of history and uncover some of the treasures of the Smithsonian Institution with a visit to the National Air and Space Museum -OR- you can enjoy the National Museum of American History. Among the National Air and Space Museum's collection in their location on the National Mall are the famous Wright 1903 Flyer, the Spirit of St. Louis, and the Apollo 11 command module. In the afternoon, we will call on Mount Vernon, the beloved home of the first U.S. president, George Washington. Wander the beautiful plantation grounds he adored and tour the home filled with 18th-century artifacts. Next, we'll arrive in Old Town Alexandria, a charming community nestled along the Potomac. Enjoy some time to stroll the cobblestone streets, view the historic Colonial architecture, and stop at some of the trendy boutiques. This evening we will dine at Gadsby's Tavern, located in the heart of Old Town Alexandria and famous for hosting George Washington, Thomas Jefferson and other founding fathers. We will also visit the Washington National Cathedral. In the afternoon, we will visit Ford's Theatre where President Abraham Lincoln was assassinated on that fateful night in 1865. Tour the theatre and hear about the timeline of events that transpired as John Wilkes Booth's plan unfolded. Our tour will finish with a visit to the neighboring Petersen House, the boarding house to which the fatally injured Lincoln was carried.



As evidenced by the photos below, the 2019 Ballard's Fishing Trip was so much fun we're going to do it all over again in 2020!


