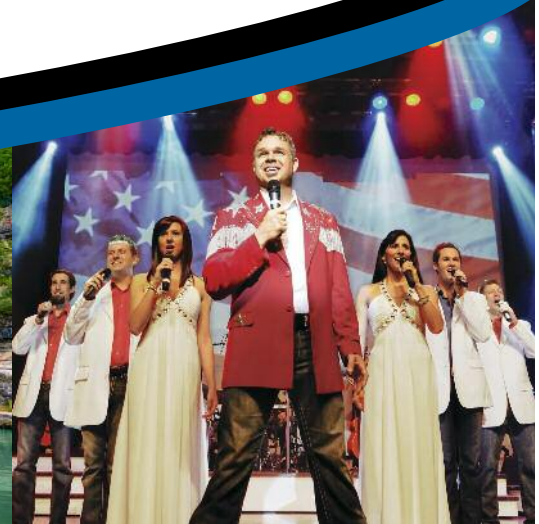

The Best of Branson

5 Days October 12-16, 2020

Day 1 – Branson, MO - SIX - Board the motorcoach this morning and travel to Branson, MO. You will also have a professional tour manager with you the entire trip. On arrival, check into the Hilton Promenade at Branson Landing for three night stay.

Dinner is included tonight at Shorty Smalls. Shorty's story begins back in 1888, when his daddy was just an ornery mining town cook who made the worst pancakes ever. (But, when you're really hungry, who gives a darn?) When Shorty grew up and inherited the family business, he got rid of all that breakfast nonsense and started making the most delicious lunches and dinners anyone had ever tasted. Folks came from miles around for Shorty's food, and they still do today.

Enjoy the 8:00 pm performance of SIX, a contemporary vocal band on power-mode, features six real brothers, Barry, Kevin, Lynn, Jak, Owen and Curtis, who take musical entertainment to a whole new level. Critically acclaimed and dubbed as "an orchestra of human voices" and "masters of showmanship", these multi-talented brothers sound like a band using only their mouths. These pioneers of a cappella are six of ten Knudsen brothers who have been singing contemporary a cappella with incredible beatbox vocals and harmonizing since they were children, over 40 years in total. **(D)**

Day 2 - Dogwood Canyon Nature Park, Tram Tour & Lunch – Wine Tasting – Legends in Concert - After breakfast, take a "ride on the wild side." Step aboard an open-air tram and explore the beauty of Dogwood Canyon on a two-hour Wildlife Tram Tour. You'll wind through the canyon floor, past towering bluffs and waterfalls, making a stop at the Glory Hole (a magnificent blue-green pool where some of our largest trout reside). Then cross the Arkansas border where your tram may mingle with herds of American bison, elk, whitetail deer and Texas longhorn. Enjoy a picnic grill lunch prior to tram ride.

Then enjoy "Happy Hour" this afternoon at a local Branson winery. Followed by dinner at Florentina's Ristorante Italiano. Dine with family and friends while enjoying the Italian traditions of food, friendship, hospitality and uniquely "Italian style"...with glasses raised, accompanied by warm smiles, welcoming arms, a little laughter and loads of conversation as Florentina's transforms into grandma Maria's kitchen or perhaps Uncle Antonio's dinner table...and everyone is family.

End the day with Legends in Concert. Each legendary performer not only looks like the star they portray, but use their own natural voices to pay homage to their iconic music counterpart. Legends in Concert live tribute shows are known for their elaborate theatrical sets, magnificent costumes and full array of incredible special effects, including three dimensional multimedia and multimillion dollar, state-of-the-art lighting and sound systems. **(B,L,D)**

Day 3 - Branson Landing – Moonshine Tasting – Lost Canyon Cave & Nature Trail – Dinner at Top of the Rock - Enjoy free time this morning at Branson Landing located on the waterfront of beautiful Lake Taneycomo in downtown Branson. With over 100 shops and entertainment and dining options. Included today is a stop at Smith Creek Distillery for a moonshine tasting. Come enjoy the moonshine tasting bar, restaurant featuring handcrafted hamburgers, and retail store with bottled shines, apparel, jams, sauces, dry rubs, and more.

This afternoon head to nearby Ridgedale, MO to visit Top of the Rock. Here you enjoy a tour of the Lost Canyon Cave & Nature Trail, an unforgettable two and a half-mile journey on an electric cart. This dramatic trail was created to highlight stunning rock formations, waterfalls and views of Table Rock Lake. Don't forget to stop at the Bat Bar for a fresh glass of lemonade.

Next, discover world-class dining at Top of the Rock, a fine dining experience complete with a glass of wine. Complete your evening with the signature Sunset Ceremony. As the sun shows its final glistening light, you will hear a civil war cannon erupt as everyone raises their glass for a toast. **(B,D)**

Day 4 - Clay Cooper Show – Lunch at Pickin Porch Grill – Meet Clay Cooper – Jefferson City, MO – This morning features the Clay Copper Show. Clay started performing in Branson at the age of 16 and now celebrates his 34rd season in Branson doing what he loves at his own theatre! His unbelievable talent, hysterical comedy and down-home personality bring the audience back time and time again. Come see Clay Cooper and his Live Band, 11 Dancers, Third Power, and Comedian Matt Gumm!

There are also have outstanding youth entertainers Colton & Caden Cooper! Clay Cooper's Country Express has something for everyone with 24 entertainers on stage, great visual effects and a variety of music – old and new country, rock, current hits, gospel, and patriotic! Lunch is included at Pickin Porch Grill a Folksy, counter-serve joint at Branson Craft Mall with BBQ plates, burgers & sides, plus live music with Special Meet & Greet from Clay Cooper during lunch.

Departing Branson after lunch, travel to Jefferson City, MO for the night. Dinner is on your own this evening. **(B,L)**

Day 5 - Depart for Home - After breakfast, depart for home. **(B)**
