UPDATE on REAL ID: Due to COVID-19, the deadline to get your REAL ID (gold star) has been extended to May 3, 2023. If you fly commercially you'll need a REAL ID license by this date. REAL ID is a federal act focusing on anti-terrorism, fraud protection, and security specific to the production of driver's licenses and ID cards that control access to certain facilities. If your license or ID will expire before May 3, 2023, you can just wait until it's time to renew and do it then. If your license will expire on or after May 3, 2023, you can go to any driver's license service center before then and get a replacement license that's marked as a REAL ID license. You will need to provide them with documents that prove your identity, SSN, date of birth and address (example: Social Security Card, Birth Certificate, piece of mail with your current address).

On day one we start the day with a visit to Providence and the Gilded Age mansions of Newport. We'll spend time in the lively artist colony of Provincetown, experience the beautiful islands of Martha's Vineyard, Block Island, and Nantucket. We'll complete our local experience as we indulge in a traditional seafood and lobster feast, explore the local charms, walk along historic cobblestone streets, and feel like a true New Englander in a traditional cranberry bog.



Day Six: Charia, Crete, Greece - Chania is a city on the northwest coast of the Greek island of Crete. It's known for its 14th-century Venetian harbor, narrow streets and waterfront restaurants. At the harbor entrance is a 16th-century lighthouse with Venetian, Egyptian and Ottoman influences. Opposite, the Nautical Museum has model ships, naval objects and photographs. The former monastery of St. Francis houses the Archaeological Museum of Chania.

Day Seven: Santorini, **Greece** - Witness a panorama of indigo-domed churches and chalk-colored homes clinging to stony cliffs along the caldera, black-sand beaches dotted with pebbles beside deep, azure waters, and breathtaking rock formations climbing from the volcanic floor-here is the epitome of Grecian beauty.


