On day one we start the day with a visit to Providence and the Gilded Age mansions of Newport. 

July 22: Seattle, Washington - Embark on your luxury cruise in the popular city of Seattle, home to the iconic Space Needle and Pike Place Market. Local and Sustainable are words to live by in Seattle. Visitors are spoiled for choices of things to do in Seattle. Whatever you end up doing, you'll fall in love with the Emerald City.

July 23: Cruising Inside Passage - While cruising the inside passage, a beautiful island-dotted waterway edged by verdant forests, mountains, and glaciers, you will catch glimpses of breathtaking rugged scenery, plus staggering wildlife like salmon sharks, white spirit bears, and millions of seabirds.

July 24: Ketchikan, Alaska - Built around salmon canneries and sawmills, Ketchikan was once proclaimed the Salmon Capital of the World. Its unique culture is celebrated through its renowned collection of totem poles, a testament to Native art. Ketchikan is backed by steep, forested slopes and fringed by a pristine waterfront. Not far in the distance is the Tongass National Forest, filled with wildlife and the peaceful aura of the North Country.

July 25: Icy Strait Point (Hoonah), Alaska - Icy Strait is home to the largest native settlement in Alaska and is laced with strong ties to their cultural heritage. Visit the beautifully restored salmon cannery, which dates back to 1930 and offers a view into Alaska's more recent past, or watch for whales spouting at the nearby Point Adolphus feeding area. Close by is culturally rich Hoonah, a Tingit fishing village.

July 26: Cruising Hubbard Glacier - View Hubbard Glacier, the longest tidewater glacier in North America, which enchants visitors with its awe-inspiring walls of ice.

July 27: Juneau, **Alaska** - The thriving town of Juneau offers an eclectic mix of people and pastimes. The busy downtown streets feature upscale shopping with a traditional twist while spectacular mountain scenery stuns from every angle. The famous Mendenhall glacier sits just outside town, and even a casual observer is likely to spot bald eagles. Humpback whales, or perhaps a black bear.

July 28: Haines, **Alaska** - Haines is a great place to see the outdoors – hiking, fishing and wildlife viewing are all popular activities. A top local attraction is the decommissioned military outpost of Fort Seward, now an historic landmark. Bird watchers take note: the world's largest concentration of bald eagles comes to the area every autumn.

July 29: Sitka, Alaska - Picturesque Sitka is known for its fishing industry, an annual music festival, and its vast array of historic attractions. The city's fascinating museum houses some of Alaska's oldest indigenous collections, and the Sitka National Historical Park boasts to tem-lined forest trails and authentic artisan exhibits.

July 30: Cruising the Outside Passage - Cruise the Outside Passage through the open blue waters of the Pacific Ocean.

July 31: Victoria, British Columbia, Canada - Western Canada's oldest city displays its civilized British heritage with pride. Visit the elaborately manicured Butchart Gardens and see the steep-gabled Craigdarroch "bonanza castle." Spend time in the beating heart of the city, the Inner Harbor, where you might enjoy the Royal BC Museum, street performers, craft vendors and more.

Day Two: Venice, Italy - Discover la bea vita (the beautiful life) in the fairytale city of Venice. Take in the glory of Venetian architecture, marble palaces and flower-strewn canals, in this timeless city of piazzas, trattorias, and charming old shops. Enjoy Venetian cuisine-inspired by its garden islands and lagoon aquaculture-expressing the city's historic ties to the ancient spice route.

Day Three: Split, Croatia - The largest city on the Adriatic Coast, Split has been under Roman, Venetian, Austrian, French, Italian, and Yugoslav rule. The Old City is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and must-see historic attractions include Diocletian's Palace, the Cathedral of Saint Domnius, and the striking Grgur Ninski Statue. Take time to stroll along the Riva Harbor, browse through the Green Market, and sample the restaurants and wine cellars.

Day Four: Kotor, Montenegro - Beneath the limestone cliffs of Mount Loven lies the dramatic and secluded coastal city of Kotor. Settled during Roman times, this walled medieval city, with its narrow streets, Venetian architecture, and the twelfth-century Saint Tryphon Cathedral, is a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Day Five: At Sea - Today is a full day at sea. Take in all the fun and excitement the ship has to offer.

Day Six: Chania, Crete, Greece - Chania is a city on the northwest coast of the Greek island of Crete. It's known for its 14th-century Venetian harbor, narrow streets and waterfront restaurants. At the harbor entrance is a 16th-century lighthouse with Venetian, Egyptian and Ottoman influences. Opposite, the Nautical Museum has model ships, naval objects and photographs. The former monastery of St. Francis houses the Archaeological Museum of Chania.

Day Seven: Santorini, Greece - Witness a panorama of indigo-domed churches and chalk-colored homes clinging to stony cliffs along the caldera, black-sand beaches dotted with pebbles beside deep, azure waters, and breathtaking rock formations climbing from the volcanic floor-here is the epitome of Grecian beauty.

Day Eight: Mykonos, Greece - Amid the shimmering waters of the Mediterranean, Mykonos is the heart and soul of the Cyclades, Situated on an island of the same name, the town artfully balances elegance and classic Greek culture within its labyrinth of cobblestone streets and chalk-white homes nestled beside bluedomed churches.

Day Nine: Athens (Piraeus), Greece - Wonder at the picturesque port of Piraeus and legendary Athens, one of the world's oldest cities. Built around the ruins of the ancient temple, the Parthenon, Athens is set between its rich modern present and its astounding past.

Day Ten: Kusadasi/Ephesus, Turkey - Kusadasi is home to one of the remaining Seven Wonders of the Ancient World-the Temple of Artemis. Nearby are the legendary ruins of the city of Ephesus whose remains are an important archaeological site and a historic Christian pilgrimage destination.

Day Eleven: Istanbul, Turkey - Indulge your senses in this magnificent city astride two continents and divided by the Bosphorus strait. Once known as Constantinople, Istanbul was the capital of both the Byzantine and Ottoman Empire. Revel in this lively cosmopolitan's fascinating blend of East and West, ancient and modernhome to the impressive Blue Mosque, Topkapi Palace, and the Grand Bazaar.
