Next we will travel to the Convivium Urban Farmstead for a tour of the gardens and we will learn all about their philosophy of creating a community around food production, preparation, preservation and enjoyment. And last but not least, before we head for home we will visit and tour Verena Street Coffee. We will learn all about this Startup Company and history, enjoy a behind the scenes tour of the roasting and packaging facility and learn all about the bean-to-cup process.

Day One: Depart for Valletta, Malta

September 3 - 14, 2022

Day Two: Valletta, Malta - Discover the myriad of cultural layers of Malta, from its amazing prehistoric temples at Tarxien to beautiful walled medieval Mdina, nearby Rabat, and Marsaxlokk, a colorful fishing village. Admire the stunning scenery and wander through imposing churches and down the streets of fortified towns where the Knights of St. John once held sway.

Day Three: Messina, Italy - Visit beautiful Taormina and marvel at its famous Greek theater and the stunning view of Mount Etna. Explore lovely medieval Messina with its historic churches and the cathedral where it is rumored Richard the Lionheart worshipped in 1190. Day Four: Igoumenitsa, Greece - An undiscovered gem on the northwest coast of Greece, Igoumenitsa stands on the site of a settlement dating to the 4th century BC, and several ancient sites are located nearby. Founded in 31 BC, the archaeological site Nikopolis was once a thriving capital built by the Roman emperor Octavian to commemorate his victory over Anthony and Cleopatra. You can also visit Meteora with its spectacular 15th century monasteries built into seemingly inaccessible sandstone peaks.

Day Five: Argostolli, Greece - This capital of the island of Cephalonia resides in a sheltered bay along Koutavos Lagoon, where you might catch a glimpse of a loggerhead turtle. The stone obelisk of the Drapano Bridge and the Lighthouse of Saint Theodore are two of the island's distinctive landmarks. Discover relics from the Mycenaean, Hellenistic and Roman periods in the city's archaeological museum.

Day Six: Chania, Crete, Greece - Chania is a city on the northwest coast of the Greek island of Crete. It's known for its 14th-century Venetian harbor, narrow streets and waterfront restaurants. At the harbor entrance is a 16th-century lighthouse with Venetian, Egyptian and Ottoman influences. Opposite, the Nautical Museum has model ships, naval objects and photographs. The former monastery of St. Francis houses the Archaeological Museum of Chania.

Day Seven: Santorini, Greece - Witness a panorama of indigo-domed churches and chalk-colored homes clinging to stony cliffs along the caldera, black-sand beaches dotted with pebbles beside deep, azure waters, and breathtaking rock formations climbing from the volcanic floor. This is the epitome of Grecian beauty.

Day Eight: Mykonos, Greece - Amid the shimmering waters of the Mediterranean, Mykonos is the heart and soul of the Cyclades. Situated on an island of the same name, the town artfully balances elegance and classic Greek culture within its labyrinth of cobblestone streets and chalk-white homes nestled beside blue-domed churches.


