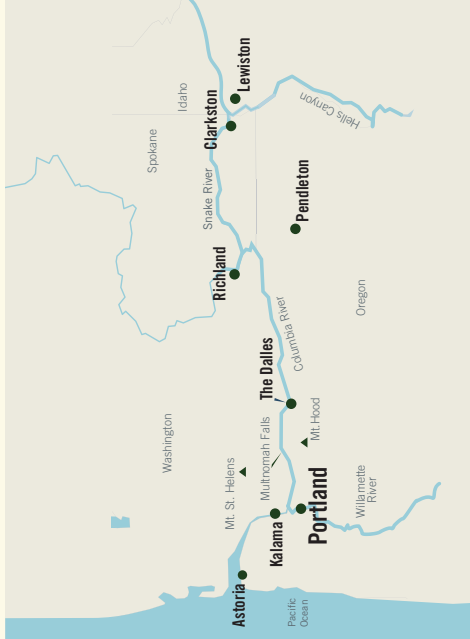

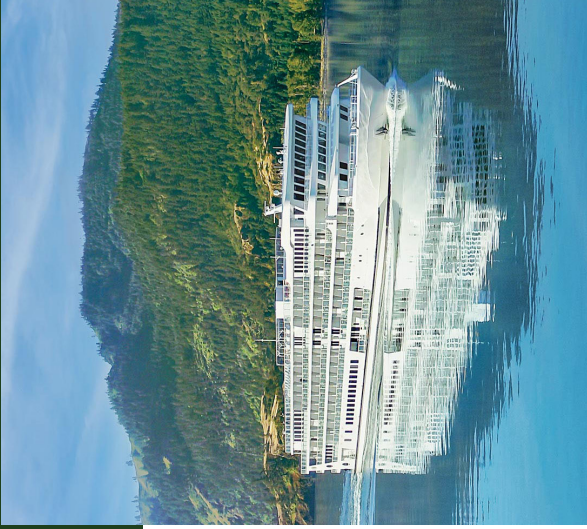

## ITINERARY

### **August 13: Portland, Oregon - *Hotel Stay***

Ease into your adventure with a hotel stay in Portland, a city known for riverside parks and a lively food and coffee culture.

### **August 14: Portland, Oregon - *Embark***

Embark in Portland, where the Willamette and Columbia Rivers meet beneath a skyline of bridges and wooded hills. Independent bookstores, craft markets, and bridges spanning the Willamette River introduce the character of the Pacific Northwest.

### **August 15: Astoria, Oregon**

Astoria sits near the mouth of the Columbia River where it meets the Pacific Ocean. Victorian homes climb the hillside above a busy waterfront, recalling the town's early role in fur trading, fishing, and maritime commerce along the Oregon coast.

### **August 16: Kalama, Washington**

Kalama lies along the Columbia River with views toward Mount St. Helens on clear days. Visitors often spend time walking the marina paths, exploring local shops, or casting a line from the riverbank in this easygoing Northwest town.

### **August 17: The Dalles, Oregon**

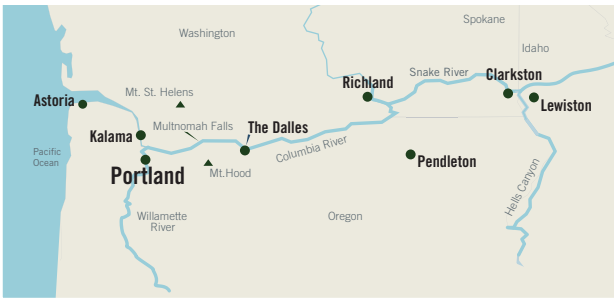
The Dalles recalls an earlier era of river travel and frontier trade along this dramatic stretch of the Columbia Gorge. Visit the Columbia Gorge Discovery Center to discover chronicles from that storied past, from the Lewis and Clark Expedition through the era of wagon trains on the Oregon Trail, which ended their overland journey here at the banks of the Columbia.

### **August 18: Cruising the Columbia River**

Along the Columbia River, see basalt cliffs, forested slopes, and wide stretches of open water carved by ancient floods and volcanic forces. A day on board allows time to relax on deck and enjoy the ship's amenities.

## **August 19: Pendleton, Oregon & Richland, Washington**

Pendleton is known for its rodeo roots and ranching traditions, while Richland lies at the confluence of the Columbia and Yakima Rivers in the heart of Washington wine country. Vineyards and tasting rooms stretch across the surrounding hills.

## **August 20: Lewiston, Idaho & Clarkston, Washington**

Lewiston and Clarkston are twin cities at the confluence of the Snake and Clearwater Rivers with a distinctly relaxed character. Nearby, the dramatic canyonlands of Hells Canyon draws visitors for scenic jet-boat rides and sweeping views through North America's deepest river gorge.

## **August 21: Clarkston, Washington - Disembark**

Disembark in Clarkston, a fitting close to a voyage tracing the landscapes and waterways of the Columbia basin.

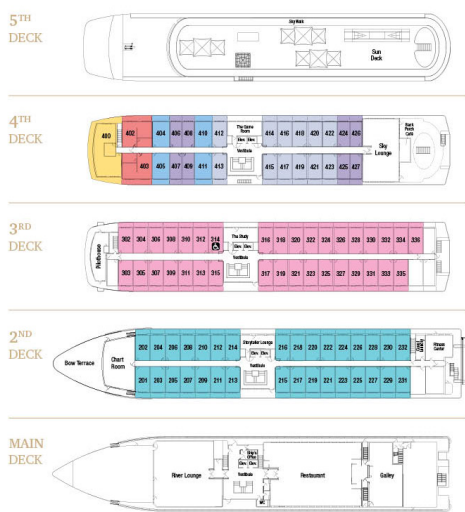
